## THIRD WEEK OF EASTER, SUNDAY, 4<sup>TH</sup> MAY 2025.

#### Reflection:

In a polite society you are not supposed to go around asking people questions like "who do you say I am?" or "Do you love me?" perhaps because the answer s might be deadening. In today's gospel reading however, Jesus asked Peter three times if he really loves him.

Remember that before the crucifixion Peter had not exactly distinguished himself. Three times he denied being a disciple of Jesus and knowing anything about him. The man Jesus chooses to exercise primacy of authority is the one who is aught out by a servant girl as he lies insistently. He is the man who is arrested by a cock crowing in the dark. From the epilogue of John's gospel, after the crucifixion, the disciples all returned to their old trade of fishing, there was no suggestion that they still believed they had a mission to carry out, their hopes were dashed as they tried to cope with the loss of the one who had changed their lives and called them to be his disciples.

After a long night's of fishing the disciples caught nothing and a distant figure on the shore tells them to try again, they did, and they caught so many fish, and the beloved disciple identifies the figure as Jesus.

After the meal Jesus asks Peter three times about the reality of his love. Insisting on love is something of a hallmark when it comes to Jesus. Three times Peter affirms his love, as three times Jesus insists on and when Peter professes his love for Jesus, Jesus commissioned him to care for his flock, in love. And that was exactly what Peter did as we heard from the first reading today.

The question of Jesus, "Do you love me?" is openly directed to us hoping for an answer. The question comes from One who had gone through enormous trouble to first assure us that he really and truly loves us, very much interested in our future than our past failures. He died for us!

That kind of person is worth letting through our defences and locked doors.
